<p>Publisher and author Susan Hawthorne was born in 1951 and raised on a farm in Wagga Wagga. She was active in student politics and joined the women's liberation group at La Trobe University and the Women's Liberation Centre roster in 1973. She established and was the first Chair of the first Women's Affairs Committee. She later became a Rape Crisis Centre and Halfway House volunteer. Working as an editor at Penguin Books (1987-1991) she initiated the Penguin Women's Library Series. In 1991 she co-founded Spinifex Press and organised the International Feminist Book Fair in Melbourne in 1994, following her earlier running of the Australian Feminist Book Fortnight in 1989. Hawthorne has written, contributed to and published many works of fiction and non-fiction.. A Women's Circus and Performing Older Women's Circus member, Hawthorne completed a PhD in Women's Studies in 2002. This collection is No.36 of the Victorian Women's Liberation and Lesbian Feminist Archive.</p>

<p>Comprises records from all aspects of Susan Hawthorne's life from her student activities to her role as an author and publisher. They include her early women's liberation and political involvement; her literary involvement as a writer, publisher and conference organiser; written drafts of her publications: correspondence with her mother and friends; the lesbian feminist movement; and her activities as a writer and circus preformer for Performing Older Women.</p> <p>The arrangement of this collection has been carried out by Susan Hawthorne and it is a box list, that is, it describes the content of each box rather than the detail of each file within each box. Nevertheless, it was her practice to arrange her papers into one or more multi-subject files per year and this arrangement has been followed for these papers. Her manuscripts are also arranged by year. Boxes are titled by Susan Hawthorne's name and a sequence number in most cases, and their contents are well described.</p>
