HISTORICAL NOTE	Alva Geikie was born on 29 January 1936 in Brunswick, Melbourne. She was state-school educated and made clothes for Myer for two years after completing a three year Needlecraft Diploma at Emily MacPherson College. A qualified teacher, she taught needlecraft in schools while studying at night for a Bachelor of Arts at Monash University. In October 1969, Geikie joined the equal pay for women activist, Zelda D'Aprano, in chaining themselves across the doors of the Arbitration Court. She became a co-founder of the Women's Action Committee in 1970 and was subsequently involved in organizing the Equal Pay Tram Ride, the anti-Miss Teenage Quests and men-only public bars protest actions. She also attended Women's Liberation Centre meetings and was an active member of Vashti's Voice and the Women's Abortion Action Campaign. In 1972, Geikie helped co-write the joint Women's Liberation Movement and Women's Electoral Lobby submission for the Equal Pay Case. In 2005 she received an Edna Ryan Award-honour her contribution as a feminist activist over many years.
