<b>HISTORICAL NOTE</b>	<p>The Women's Liberation Halfway House was Victoria's first women's refuge. It was established without funding in 1974 by a group of activists in response to the huge number of calls to the Women's Liberation Centre from women experiencing domestic violence. A house was donated rent-free in Kew for the first year and staffed by rostered volunteers. With Halfway House as a model, more refuges were set up in other suburbs. After some piece-meal funding from philanthropic and government bodies, Halfway House received full government funding in the federal Budget of 1977. In the late 1980s the needs of women from non-English-speaking backgrounds became Halfway House's focus.</p> <p>This collection is No.100 of the Victorian Women's Liberation and Lesbian Feminist Archive.</p>

<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	The Women's Liberation Halfway House collection comprises the records of their women's refuge such as meeting minutes, lists of residents, finance and legal documents which are mostly embargoed. It also contains correspondence which relates to organisations and government departments, periodicals and publications as well as research papers, conferences, a film, a poster and audio recordings.

<b>NOTE ON COLLECTIONS</b>	<p>Some folders in the boxes are embargoed until 2070 to protect the anonymity and confidentiality of residents and children. Embargoed records are those which do or might mention a resident and/or children by name – especially logbooks, Monday night meetings, newsletters from any refuges and financial records especially receipts.</p> <p>EMBARGOED materials within boxes are labelled on this list with the word EMBARGO. An * after it indicates it has been placed in a special embargo envelope at the front of the box in which it is listed. It should not be released to researchers.</p> <p>Whole boxes of EMBARGOED material are listed and marked on the outside and described as EMBARGOED on the list.</p> <p>Many of the folders that are part of the collection have original details, and were kept. They are now correctly numbered within this list.</p> <p>Materials relating to the Women's Liberation Halfway House which were originally from other collections (as noted on the folders e.g., Victorian Women Refuge Group No 48) but removed to this collection for confidentiality, are noted on this listing.</p> <p>Posters from this collection have been removed to separate storage and are detailed on a master list attached to the Victorian Women's Liberation and Lesbian Feminist Archive catalogue Registration Number 2010.0011.
