It amalgamated with the Federated Felt Hatting and Allied Trade Employees Union of Australia in 1984, and with the Boot and Clothing trade unions thereafter to form the Textile Clothing & Footwear Union of Australia in 1992.

GENERAL NOTE: The collection covers the period from 1920 to 1976 with the bulk of the documents from between 1970 to 1972. The term "Provincial Division" was first used in the minutes of the meeting in 1970 while earlier meetings were held by the regional divisions. The greatest activity of the Union and therefore the greatest number of documents come from the war and early post war years and deal with spinning, weaving, knitting and finishing of the industry in Western Victoria, exclusive of Geelong. The Provincial Division dealt only with local issues and the documents with the Victorian Branch, the Federal Council in Sydney and other Unions are in the main reports of General Union interest as well as awards, rates and conditions applicable to the industry as a whole. The correspondence therefore deals mainly with matters of organisation, fee collection and minor disputes as well as follow up of compensation cases. The financial records are almost complete.
