HISTORICAL NOTE	<p>Kathleen Elizabeth Fitzpatrick, nee Pitt, was born on 7 September 1905 in Omeo, Victoria. She attended the University of Melbourne, graduating with honours in Arts in 1926. Fitzpatrick then went to Oxford where she completed another undergraduate degree. Returning to Australia she briefly found employment at the University of Sydney before becoming a tutor in the English department at the University of Melbourne in 1930, a position she was forced to resign from upon marriage in 1932 to then journalist, later historian, Brian Fitzpatrick. Following the failure of the marriage a couple of years later, she taught shorthand and typing for several years before being appointed lecturer in the University's history department in 1938. She remained there until her retirement in 1962, becoming Associate Professor in 1948. Renowned for her inspirational teaching, she exerted a powerful influence on several generations of history students. Her best-known publications are 'Sir John Franklin in Tasmania' (1949), 'Australian Explorers' (1953), 'Martin Boyd' (1963) and the highly-acclaimed 'Solid Bluestone Foundations' in 1983. A foundation member of the Australian Humanities Research Council and Foundation Fellow of the Australian Academy of the Humanities, Kathleen Fitzpatrick was awarded the Order of Australia in 1989. She died on 27 August, 1990.</p>
