The group eventually set up a small bookshop at the Women's Cultural Palace in 1979 where a number of publications were for sale including <i>Monster</i> , a pirated (with permission) edition of poetry by Robin Morgan, <i>Broadsheet</i> , the feminist magazine from Aotearoa, New Zealand, <i>Young, Gay and Proud</i> , published by the Melbourne Gay Teachers and Students Group, <i>Hecate</i> , a Women's Interdisciplinary Journal published in Queensland, <i>Off Our Backs</i> from the US plus a selection of fiction and non-fiction books by feminists and lesbians.
