Creator's Historical Note

A graduate of the University of Melbourne, Sunderland was appointed Senior Lecturer of Human Anatomy in 1936 while holding the position of Honorary Assistant Neurologist and Neurosurgeon at the Alfred Hospital. At the end of 1937 he became Demonstrator in Human Anatomy at the University of Oxford, where he continued his research in neuroanatomy. In July 1938 he was appointed Professor of Anatomy at Melbourne. From 1940-1945 he was in charge of a Peripheral Nerve Injury Unit at the A.G.M.H. at Heidelberg. He was Dean of Medicine from 1953 until 1971, and Professor of Experimental Neurology from 1961 until he retired in 1975.

Sir Sydney Sunderland

1906 - 1993

Career Summary

Sydney Sunderland, 1910-1993, Professor of Anatomy (1939-1961), Professor of Experimental Neurology (1961-1975), Dean of Medicine, University of Melbourne, (1953-1971).

During World War II Sunderland was in charge of a Peripheral Nerve Injury Unit at the Australian General Military Hospital at Heidelberg. This led to a lasting interest and pioneering involvement in peripheral nerve research. Sunderland was seen as a world authority in this field and published two books on the subject. Sunderland was involved in a variety of organisations within Australia and overseas. He held teaching positions in the United Kingdom and the United States and was also involved in the development of medical education in developing countries. As Dean, Sunderland oversaw a substantial expansion of the Faculty of Medicine. Sunderland was knighted in 1971 and became Professor Emeritus upon his retirement in 1975.

Biographical Note

Professor Sydney Sunderland, CMG(1960), MBBS(Melb 1935), MD(Melb 1946), BS, DSc(Melb 1945), FRACP(1941), FRACS(1952 Hons), FAA(1954), MD(Tas 1970), MD(Qld 1975 Hons), LLD(Melb 1975 Hons), LLD(Monash 1977 Hons).

Sydney Sunderland was born in Brisbane on 31 December 1910. He was educated at Kelvin Grove Boys' State School (Brisbane), Scotch College (Melbourne) and Brisbane High School, where he was Dux in 1929. Sunderland gained an open scholarship to the University of Queensland and in 1930 he won the Raff Memorial Scholarship for first year medical students. In 1931 Sunderland went to the University of Melbourne, and in 1935, his final year of medicine, he passed with first class honours and won three out of four possible scholarships: the Keith Levi Memorial for medicine, the Fulton Scholarship for obstetrics and gynaecology and the Jamieson prize for medicine. During vacations Sunderland worked at the Baker Medical Research Institute.

In 1936 Sydney Sunderland was appointed Senior Lecturer of Human Anatomy at the University of Melbourne and at the same time held the position of Honorary Assistant Neurologist and Neurosurgeon at the Alfred Hospital. At the end of 1937 he took up the position of Demonstrator in Human Anatomy at the University of Oxford, where he continued his research in neuroanatomy. In July 1938, at the age of 27, Sunderland was appointed Professor of Anatomy at the University of Melbourne. In 1939 he was married to Gwendoline Johnston, a law graduate of Melbourne University.

From 1940 to 1945, with the rank of Honorary Major, Sydney Sunderland was in charge of a Peripheral Nerve Injury Unit at the Australian General Military Hospital at Heidelberg. This led to a lasting interest and pioneering involvement in peripheral nerve research.

In the years following World War II Sunderland was involved in a variety of activities and organisations at local, national and international levels. He was involved with medicine in developing countries, advising on the setting-up of medical schools in Burma, Malaysia, Singapore and Indonesia. Sunderland's involvement in the advancement of medicine, especially neurosurgery, was recognised by invitations to speak in over fifty different countries and by membership of a number of professional associations in Australia and other countries. From 1953 to 1954 he was

Visiting Professor of Anatomy at John-Hopkins University in Baltimore and Visiting Professor of Orthopaedic
Surgery at the University of California in 1977. He was made an Honorary Member of the American Neurological
Association, he was a member of the Neurological Society of Australasia and was Vice-President of the
International Association for the Study of Pain from 1975 to 1978. An international society dedicated to the study of
peripheral nerve injury and repair was established and named the Sunderland Society in 1980.

Sunderland became Dean of Medicine at the University of Melbourne in 1953, a post he held until 1971. He was a member of the University Council from 1955 to 1967. In 1961 he moved to the Chair of Experimental Neurology. As Dean of Medicine Sunderland was responsible for the establishment of the first chairs of Medicine and Surgery in the Medical School, as well as new Chairs in Child Health, Radiology, Ophthalmology, Otolaryngology and Psychiatry; while he was Dean the number of Chairs in the Medical School rose from 7 to 24. A new Clinical School was established at the Austin Hospital and Clinical Sciences Buildings were established within the major teaching hospitals. The new Medical Building was opened in 1968. The main lecture theatre in the building is named for him. The university has a Sunderland Prize in Neuroscience in the medical course.

Sydney Sunderland was created a knight companion of the Order of St Michael and St George in 1971. After retirement, in 1975, Sunderland continued research activities and writing as Professor Emeritus in the Anatomy Department.

Throughout his long working life Sunderland published a large number of articles in professional journals, as well as two books, "Nerves and Nerve Injuries" in 1968, and "Nerve Injuries and Their Repair: A Critical Appraisal" in 1991.

Sir Sydney Sunderland died on the 27th of August 1993.
