<b>HISTORICAL NOTE</b>	On 21 March 1959, the University celebrated a long-sought ambition when the Prime Minister Robert Menzies opened the new Baillieu Library. The donation for the building was received in 1944, the site selected in 1952, the plans and working drawings prepared in 1954 and the building was erected between March 1957 and December 1958. This was the first library project of significance since the new Public Library of New South Wales in 1942. The Baillieu Library boasted 90,000 square feet of floor space, could accommodate 1000 readers and at least 300,000 books. The plans allowed for additional extensions which was fortuitous because by 1960 the University was reporting that accommodation was inadequate. The library received large donations from the W.L. Baillieu Trust.
