**HISTORICAL  
NOTE**

Sir Arthur Barton Pilgrim AMIES was born in Perth on 17 October 1902. He was educated at Perth Modern School and the University of Melbourne (B.D.Sc., 1924). In 1926 he went to Edinburgh University, Edinburgh, Scotland where he qualified L.R.C.P., L.R.C.S. in 1928. After a short period of travelling he returned to Melbourne and a part-time position at the (Royal) Dental Hospital Melbourne. He also entered private practice at Pasteur House, 30-34 Collins Street, Melbourne. During this time he was also studying at the University of Melbourne for a D.D.Sc. (1929) and a Diploma of Laryngology and Otology (1933).

In 1934 following the resignation of Professor F.C. Wilkinson to take up a position in the United Kingdom, Amies was appointed Professor of Dental Science (later Dental Medicine and Surgery) at the University of Melbourne. This appointment simultaneously made him Dean of the Faculty of Dental Science, Principal of the Australian College of Dentistry and Dean of the Dental Hospital.

Amies joined the Australian Imperial Force on 19 June 1940 as a Major in the Australian Army Medical Corps, Dental Service. He served with the 4<sup>th</sup> Australian General Hospital at Tobruk, and a facio-maxillary and plastic unit attached to 2<sup>nd</sup> Australian General Hospital in Egypt. He returned to duties at the University in 1942.

During his career Amies actively participated in many university, professional and community organisations. He was President of the Victorian Branch of the Australian Dental Association, 1936-37 and Federal President of the Association, 1938-39. A member of the Dental Board of Victoria, 1933-35 and 1955-1958. He was also President of the Victorian College of Optometry. In 1966 the College's main lecture theatre was named in honour of Amies contribution to the College. Amies was also involved with Returned Servicemen's organisations. He was patron of the 'Rats of Tobruk' and in 1955 was President of Melbourne Legacy.

Amies academic distinctions included Fellowships of Royal Society of Edinburgh, American College of Dentists. He was a Fellow in Dental Surgery of both the Royal College of Surgeons of England and the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh and a Fellow of the (Royal) Australian College of Dental Surgeons.

In recognition of service to dental science he was made a Companion of the Order of St Michael and St George (CMG) 1949. Then in 1957 in recognition of service to dentistry as Dean at the University of Melbourne he was made a Knight Bachelor.

From as early as 1935 Amies was one of the prime movers behind the development of a new Dental Hospital. After much lobbying the Victorian government made the site of the Old Haymarket available for a new Dental Hospital. Amies's idea became a reality when the Victorian Premier Sir Henry Bolte opened the new hospital in May 1963.
