HISTORICAL NOTE:

C L Baillieu was born in Kew, Victoria 24 Sep 1889, the eldest of eight children of Hon William Lawrence Baillieu and Bertha Martha Latham. He was educated at Melbourne C of E Grammar School after a year at Camberwell Grammar School and then went on to Trinity College, University of Melbourne before transferring to Magdalen College, Oxford University where he took an MA. After being called to the Bar in 1914 and admitted to the Inner Temple he returned to Melbourne. Shortly after, he joined the AIF in which he served with distinction, being mentioned in despatches and awarded an OBE. He was a Major in the army and a temporary Lieutenant-Colonel in the RFC. Baillieu married Ruby Clarke in 1915 and fathered three sons and a daughter.

Although trained in the law Baillieu's career was in industry where, before the Second World War, he took up the chairmanship of several non-ferrous metal producers. During the war he was appointed as an executive member of the British Export Council before becoming Director-General of the British Purchasing Commission in the USA, head of the British Raw Materials Mission and the British representative on the Combined Raw Materials Board. In these roles Baillieu was "more than any single individual, responsible for ensuring that Britain received a fair share of resources at fair prices in a fair flow". Following the war Baillieu secured senior board posting in Dunlop Rubber, Fairey Aviation Company and the Federation of British Industries. Baillieu's diplomatic and business skills were used by both sides of Government in Britain and he was rewarded accordingly. He was awarded the additional honours of CMG in 1929, KBE 1938, and an hereditary peerage in 1953

Baron Baillieu of Sefton and Parwood took his title from the family's property "Sefton" at Macedon, Victoria, and his home, "Parkwood" at Englefield Green, Egham in Surrey, England. Baillieu played a major role in Anglo-American relations after WWII and had a long-term involvement with the English Speaking Union and the British Institute of Management of which he was a founder. He died suddenly in Melbourne on 19 Jun 1967.

DESCRIPTION:	A comprehensive collection of papers including diaries, correspondence, speeches, invitations, newspaper cuttings, photographs and ephemera. Subject files relate to Baillieu's business and personal interests and include family history and fishing and shooting. The bulk of the records date from the 1940s.
