BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE	<p>Ursula Hoff was born in London on December 26, 1909, the only child of German parents. She was educated in Germany and England and in 1934 was awarded a PhD from Hamburg for a thesis on Rembrandt, studying under renowned art historian Erwin Panofsky. She later worked at the Warburg and Courtauld Institutes in London before accepting a position as a secretary at the University of Melbourne's University College in 1939. In 1943 she joined the staff of the National Gallery of Victoria; she was the first university-trained art historian to work in an Australian gallery. She was the Assistant Keeper at the NGV from 1943-1949, Curator of Prints and Drawings from 1956 and Assistant Director from 1968-1973. Upon retirement she became the London-based advisor to the NGV's Felton Bequests Committee until 1984. After returning to Melbourne Dr Hoff resumed teaching at the University's Fine Arts Department, where she had been teaching part-time since 1948. She published dozens of essays, books on Charles Conder, Arthur Boyd and a multi-volume catalogue of pre-1800 European paintings in the NGV, amongst others. She was awarded honorary doctorates from Melbourne, Monash and LaTrobe universities; an OBE in 1970 and an Order of Australia in 1985. Ursula Hoff died in Melbourne on January 10 2005.</p>

1	1	<p>Correspondence [14 boxes] <i>Note on arrangement and listing.</i> Correspondence has been arranged according to UH's own filing system, which was to file alphabetically by correspondent's surname or by the name of the organisation that they represented. This is why, for example, Patrick McCaughey is filed under 'M' while other NGV staff may appear under 'NGV : [name]' Letters have then been arranged, as far as possible, chronologically beginning with earliest date. Where letters are undated and where date cannot be gleaned from a postmark or other internal evidence they have usually been left within the sequence that they were originally in (i.e. in UH's own filing system) on the grounds that this is the most likely to be authentic.</p> <p>The correspondence listed below is mostly incoming correspondence. UH didn't usually make or retain copies of her own outgoing correspondence but she did often draft letters by hand before making a typed version to send. These drafts, where they exist, have been interfiled with the incoming letters although this is not indicated in each of the listings below, which are file listings only, rather than item descriptions.</p>	1910-2004
