HISTORICAL NOTE	The literary journal <i>Scripsi</i> was founded by Peter Craven and Michael Heyward in 1981, initially out of the University of Melbourne's English department, where both were post-graduate students. They wanted to publish modernist critics, poets and fiction-writers from both Australia and overseas and were immediately successful in both the calibre of the writers they were able to attract and with their own critical reception. The editors soon relocated the journal to Ormond College where it remained until its demise in 1994, partly owing to a reduction in the funding it received from the Australia Council. After Michael Heyward departed in 1989 Peter Craven was assisted with the editing by John Forbes, Andrew Rutherford and others. 'Scripsi of the Air' was a weekly radio show Heyward and Craven and others presented on 3RRR for several years in the 1980s.
