HISTORICAL NOTE	<p>William John TUCKFIELD was born on 15 December 1881 at Belfast (Port Fairy), Victoria. The seventh child of the Rev James William Tuckfield and Ann Tuckfield nee Patterson, he received the Diploma of the Australian College of Dentistry and was registered with the Dental Board of Victoria as a dentist in 1902. In 1911 he married Marcella Mabel Monckton at St Matthew's Anglican Church in Prahran.</p> <p>During World War 1 1915-1918) Tuckfield served with the Australian Medical Corps (Dental Service) becoming honorary captain in July 1917.</p> <p>In 1908 Tuckfield was appointed a member of the Faculty of Dental Science, University of Melbourne and served continuously until his retirement in 1959. He was appointed a lecturer in 1913 and continued his association with teaching until 1953. In 1949 when the Chair of Dental Prosthetics was created Tuckfield became the Acting Professor. He was Dean of the Faculty 1922-23 and acting Dean on many occasions.</p> <p>From 1914 until 1956 Tuckfield edited the Australian Journal of Dentistry and became Editor Emeritus of it's replacement the Australian Dental Journal. Tuckfield was active in professional bodies such as the Odontological Society of Victoria (President 1910), the Alumni Society of the Australian College of Dentistry (President 1921) and the Australian Dental Association (President 1939-41). He was also Chairman and President of the Australian College of Dentistry and the Dental Hospital 1915-16.</p> <p>Tuckfield went to live in Queensland in 1967 and died there on 19 December 1969.</p> <p>See the following for details of Tuckfield's life and activities: <i>Australian Dental Journal</i>, Feb 1970 <i>University of Melbourne Gazette</i>, Vol 26, No 1, March 1970 <i>Australian Dictionary of Biography – Online Edition</i> - http://www.adb.online.anu.edu.au/biogs/A120314b.htm</p>
