HISTORICAL NOTE	<ul> <li>The Organ Historical Trust of Australia was formed at a public meeting held in St.Paul's Cathedral Chapter House, Melbourne, on the 13th of May 1977. Conceived as a means of extending the work done by the National Trust of Australia, its stated aims are: (1) to preserve historic pipe organs and organ building records, (2) to stimulate public interest in pipe organs which are of national or local importance, and (3) to encourage scholarly research into the history of the organ, its musical use, and organ music.</li> <li>In order to fulfil some of these aims, the society regularly produces a newsletter, `O.H.T.A. News', convenes an annual conference (the first being in 1978) and, when awarded a Myer Foundation grant and later an ANZAC Fellowship, employed John Stiller as a Research Officer to travel throughout Victoria, N.S.W. &amp; South Australia documenting pipe organs of `outstanding historical significance.'</li> <li>While membership of the O.H.T.A. remains open to all, it was, in its inception, thought that most members would fall into one of four categories - (i) those with a general interest; (ii) those with a specific historical interest; (iii) organ builders; and (iv) university staff who teach the pipe organ or related subjects.</li> <li>Financially, the Trust was established as a non-profit organisation. Its income is derived from membership subscriptions, grants (e.g. Myer Foundation, ANZAC Fellowship), donations (e.g. a donation made by Charles Ivor Matthews in the form of a scholarship establishment fund), and fund raising appeals. Apart from the Research Officer's salary, other main expenses include the publication of the `O.H.T.A. News', the organisation of the annual conference and occasional appeals for the preservation of specific pipe organs (e.g. the James Moyle organ in 1983).</li> </ul>

	The records of the organ building company, Hill, Norman and Beard (Australia) Pty. Ltd (Accession number 93/56) complement the O.H.T.A. material and enhance the overall research value of the collection. These records include four books and one file of specification & orders, numerous architectural drawings, and brief biographical notes about the company's employees.
