HISTORICAL NOTE

The `Manufacturers and Exhibitors Association of Victoria' was formed during "a meeting of gentlemen connected with manufacturing industries" on February 16, 1877. Resulting from that meeting, the Association's first office was established in Collins Street, Melbourne and a full-time Secretary was employed. As this original name suggests, one of the Association's founding objectives was to construct and manage a permanent exhibition building. With this objective quickly met - on July 9, 1878 the Victorian Government announced it would promote `the erection of the Exhibition Buildings in Carlton Gardens' - the Association was free to focus on its role as an advocate for the interests of manufacturing industries in matters such as, labour relations, tariff and taxation policy, technical education, and intercolonial free trade.

In August 1881 the Association changed its name to `The Chamber of Manufactures'. With the rapid growth of trade unionism during the 1880's, the Chamber increasingly saw its role in opposition to that of Trades Hall. `Members of the Chamber realised that "the employers of labour, as a whole, required to watch their own interests and if they did not take care, the Trades Hall Council would become such a power in the land that the manufacturers would have to do what they were told".'

It was in this adversarial spirit that the Chamber approached many future social and labour reforms, opposing initiatives such as the Conciliation and Arbitration Bill (1903) which sought to establish a minimum wage, the various campaigns for shorter working weeks, the 1942 push for equal pay for women doing war-time work, and the post-war creation of the `Welfare State'.

While the Chamber had often been forced to concede ground in the area of industrial relations, it remained a strong and respected voice for conservative interests in economic and social debates. With the formation of new trade divisions during the 1940s and 1950s its membership continued to grow in number and political influence. During the Menzies era of government the Chamber saw one its most fundamental principles become entrenched economic policy, that is, the maintenance of a tariff barrier which greatly protected Australian industries from the competition of overseas imports.

In an attempt to control inflation, the Whitlam Government, in July 1973, made a 25% across-the-board tariff reduction. The Chamber protested against this, and subsequent changes to tariff policy.

On 8 February, 1985 the Victorian Chamber of Manufactures (V.C.M.) changed its name to the Australian Chamber of Manufactures (A.C.M.). The newly named organisation was registered, and thereby incorporated, under the Commonwealth Industrial Relations Act 1988.

THE COLLECTION

Comprising two separate accessions, the first relating to the core business of the Victorian Chamber of Manufactures, the second to V.C.M./A.C.M. member Sections and Associations, this collection provides a detailed picture of the development of the organisation from its inception in 1877 through to the mid-1980s.

While the collection is particularly strong in the area of minute books (among other things, providing an unbroken sequence of V.C.M. Council minutes from 1877 through to 1974), it is less comprehensive in the area of correspondence, where it provides a record of early V.C.M. outward correspondence, but contains no inward material and nothing after 1907. Like the minute book series, the press cutting books represent material from both accessions and, in the case of those relating directly to the V.C.M., are more or less sequential beyond 1944.
