Introduction:

Brian Boyd became a builders' labourer in Gladstone, Queensland in late 1970. In 1971 he joined the Victorian BLF and worked as a parttime builders' labourer while finishing his tertiary studies. While a student, he was also active in the anti-Vietnam War movement. In 1976 he became a full time builders' labourer and in 1979, a part-time organiser for the BLF. From 1980 he was successively a full-time onthe-road organiser, organiser for the Melbourne central business district, national industrial officer and later, national asbestos and health and safety officer. In 1988 he resigned from the BLF and became an elected Industrial Officer at the Victorian Trades Hall Council. In 1991 he published *Inside the BLF*, an account of the de-registration of the BLF in the 1980s under Norm Gallagher.

The Arrangement of the Collection:

This collection was compiled by Brian Boyd during the course of his work for the BLF from the 1970s on, and especially during the 1980s when successive deregistration attempts and court cases were pursued against Gallagher and the Union. The collection documents these cases and the BLF's industrial campaigns and responses. Much of this material was used by Boyd when writing $Inside\ the\ BLF$.

The voluminous collection has been arranged into artificial series. The main identifiable series of files in the collection (Series 1, BLF History 1971-1990) was compiled by Mr. Boyd by collecting all relevant documents during the day and filing them in a manila folder for the current month. Each folder therefore contains flyers, leaflets, agenda, minutes, posters, court transcripts, and newscuttings, in rough chronological order. This original order within folders has been retained. Folders have been arranged chronologically by month as created. Brief notes of the main events covered in each folder/file have been included where possible, but *Inside the BLF* (Series 24) is the best guide to the chronology of events.

Other series of documents in this collection have similarly been arranged chronologically. Records which were grouped together by Mr. Boyd in non-chronological ways have also been kept together. Records can therefore be usefully cross-referenced; for example, many photographs in Series 23 illustrate events and transactions in Series 1.

BLF HISTORY, 1971-1990

This series contains Boyd's main chronological files, starting from 1971. The early files were less frequent and contained a smaller range of information. Files increased in internal complexity and frequency as the campaigns against the BLF increased in the 1980's, culminating in the raids on the Union in 1987 and deregistration proceedings.

In the following inventory, files are described by date range, type of document contained and/or by main issues/events covered where possible.
