HISTORICAL NOTE	Brian Boyd became a builders' labourer in Gladstone, Queensland in late 1970. In 1971 he joined the Victorian BLF and worked as a part-time builders' labourer while finishing his tertiary studies. While a student, he was also active in the anti-Vietnam War movement. In 1976 he became a full time builders' labourer and in 1979, a part-time organiser for the BLF. From 1980 he was successively a full-time on- the-road organiser, organiser for the Melbourne central business district, national industrial officer and later, national asbestos and health and safety officer. In 1988 he resigned from the BLF and became an elected Industrial Officer at the Victorian Trades Hall Council (VTHC). In 1991 he published <i>Inside the BLF</i> , an account of the deregistration of the BLF in the 1980s under Norm Gallagher. He was elected Secretary of the VTHC in 2005.
