# Florence Nightingale Committee OF AUSTRALIA VICTORIAN BRANCH COLLECTION

## HISTORICAL NOTE:

The Florence Nightingale Committee of Australia, Victorian Branch was initially formed c.1934 as the Florence Nightingale International Memorial, Victorian Committee at the request of the Florence Nightingale International Foundation, London. The Victorian Committee thus joined similar committees in South Australia and Western Australia. These Committees went into recess in 1939 due to the outbreak of War, and were only revived after hostilities ceased in 1945. The Victorian organisation was also known as the Florence Nightingale International Foundation, Victorian Committee during 1945-46 and adopted its present name at the National Biennial Conference in Canberra in 1955.

Following the post-war redevelopment of state committees, a conference was held in December 1946 attended by two representatives from each committee, and two from the Royal Australian Nursing Federation (the Federal body and forerunner of the current ANF Federal Office) and the Australian Red Cross Society. The National Florence Nightingale Memorial Committee of Australia was thus formed.

The object of the FNCA Victorian Branch as set out in the revised Constitution in 1947 was to promote and co-ordinate post-graduate education of nurses; to develop facilities for post-graduate and diploma education for selected Victorian nurses; to establish scholarships for post-graduate education; to encourage qualified nurses to undertake senior teaching or administrative education; to encourage the establishment of a Royal College of Nursing in Australia; to promote the objects of the National Florence Nightingale Committee; to encourage senior students to continue their education with a view to entering the senior ranks of nursing.<sup>2</sup>

To facilitate their activities, the FNCA Victorian Branch set up Finance, Selection, Ways and Means, and Educational Sub-committees.

The [Scholarship] Selection Committee commenced on 4 January 1946 to award the annual Red Cross Scholarship and two Florence Nightingale International Foundation, Victorian Branch Scholarships. The records of this committee are incomplete in the following collection but minutes can be found at 1/1, 1/2 and 7/16 below; correspondence can be found at 6/8, 6/9, 6/10, 7/16 and 7/17.

not represented in this collection, and only the early minutes of the Ways and Means Committee are represented in the second FNC Minute book, 1/2.

To further post-graduate education, the NFNCA was instrumental in setting up the College of Nursing Australia in 1949. The Victorian FNC and the Victorian State Committee of the CNA entered into discussion to reach agreement on post-graduate nursing education. The outcome was the formation of a joint sub-committee to raise funds for post-graduate education. In 1953 the Royal Victorian College of Nursing joined the committee and it was renamed the Victorian Post Graduate Nursing Education Committee - Joint Appeal.

Both the National and Victorian Florence Nightingale Committees of Australia are still extant.
