**HISTORICAL NOTE:** The Hickinbotham family has acquired distinction as vigneron in Australia. Alan (1899-1959) was founding scientific lecturer in the Diploma of Oenology at Roseworthy Agricultural College, SA. His son Ian, who came to Victoria in 1964 as Penfolds manager, was a technically innovative winemaker who was heavily involved in the development and marketing of wine casks. He achieved distinction as a winemaker, restaurateur, and wine educator. His sons, Stephen and Andrew, and daughter Jenny were responsible for the Cab Mac process and the Fermenter bag®.
