HISTORICAL NOTE	Gwendolen Carnegie was born 1 September 1905, and educated at Ruyton Girls' School and the University of Melbourne. Intending initially to study for a science degree, in the event she enrolled in Arts; however, since at the time it was necessary to take one science subject, she chose zoology, and was awarded the Baldwin Spencer Prize in 1927. She married Frederick Sheppard (Erick) Grimwade (b. 1904 d. 6 Mar 1950) in 1928 and was the mother of Sir Andrew Grimwade (q.v.) and aunt of Sir Roderick Carnegie (q.v.). Mrs. Grimwade's voluntary work included membership of the Board of the Royal Children's Hospital. She was the longest serving President of the Ministering Children's League "The Cottage by the Sea", Queenscliff. Gwendolen Grimwade died on 17 October 2004.
