HISTORICAL NOTE	David Orme Masson (1858- 1937). Masson was the second child and only son of David Mather Masson and his wife Emily Rosaline Orme. Masson had three sisters, Helen, Flora and Rosaline Orme Masson. He was educated at Edinburgh University, where he obtained M.A in 1878, B.Sc in 1880, D. Sc. in 1884. He held a lectureship for one year under Professor William Ramsay at University College, Bristol and Resident Fellowship at Edinburgh from 1884 to 1886. In the same year Masson was appointed Professor of Chemistry at the University of Melbourne, holding it until his retirement in 1923. In addition to his University duties, Masson made a significant contribution to the advancement of science, he took a leading part in the Foundation of the Advisory Council of Science and Industry (later known as CSIRO) and at various times presided over a number of national scientific and research organizations. Masson married Mary Struthers in 1886 at Aberdeen in Scotland. His first born son was (Sir) James Irvine Orme Masson who married Flora L. Gulland. Masson's wife, son and his daughter, Flora Marjorie (Marnie) wife of Sir Walter Bassett, survived him. He was predeceased by his daughter Elsie Rosaline, wife of the anthropologist Bronislaw (Bronio) Malinowski. (ADB, Vol 10 1891-1939)

NOTE ON COLLECTION	This collection consists of the correspondence of David Orme and Mary Masson with their families: correspondence from Orme Masson's sisters, Flora and Rosaline; to and from his children, Irvine, Marnie and Elsie, their spouses and children; and from others to the family on the death of its members. There is a small collection of documents from the working life of David Orme Masson in Series 13.
NOTE ON LISTING	This collection consists of correspondence of David Orme Masson with family members which were arranged by Masson's Biographer, Len Weickhardt during his research for <i>Masson of Melbourne</i> .
	Correspondence was arranged by Weickhardt according to correspondent and in chronological order in most cases, and each letter was described in detail. This current listing follows the order established by Dr Weickhardt and his descriptions of individual letters are held on lists within files. Not all files contain such a detailed list. The term "[no list]" signifies that the Weickhardt has not provided a sheet which describes each of the letters within the file. Notes are included where what is in the file deviates from what is on Weickhardt's lists.
	When this listing project commenced, the correspondence had been considerably disordered since Weickhardt's time, partly due to Weickhardt's research itself during which his photocopies of correspondence had been inserted back into files and correspondence moved around between files. Photocopies were checked against originals and removed, except where originals could not be found, and every attempt was made to place originals back according to the original lists or to note deviations from the lists.
	Some names of correspondents have been abbreviated by the biographer in his lists, these include David Orme Masson which has been shortened to DOM and Mary Masson to MM. Confusion is sometimes introduced by the habit of reusing family names, for example, Flora which was the name of DOM's sister, his daughter and coincidentally, his daughter-in-law. Within the family, nick names were used to help clarify this situation: DOM was always Orme, and Mary Masson was called 'Molly' by her sisters-in-law. Orme and Mary's daughter, Flora Marjorie was always Marnie, and J. Irvine Masson was always Irvine. Bronislaw Malinowski was shortened to Bronio. All other names are provided in full.
