HISTORICAL NOTE:

The origins of this brewery trace to 1858 when John Wood opened a brewery in Collingwood. It traded as Wood and Ware until 1865 when it was restructured as John Wood & Sons. It closed in 1880. In 1883 James, Charles and John Wood sons of the late John Wood reopened the brewery and four years later the brothers formed Wood & Sons Yorkshire Brewery Company Limited. The business collapsed in 1893 and the assets sold. The building was ultimately acquired by Carlton and United Breweries. [Source Deutsher, Keith M. *The Breweries of Australia: A History*, 1999]
