Historical Note:	<p>Full Name: Yarnold, Stephen Edwin (Born: Hogben, Stephen Edwin). Born: 1903. Died: 1978. Sex: Male. Collection Category: Other, private. Address: Deceased. Activity/ies: Chaplain. Location/s: Melbourne.</p> <p>Historical note: Born Stephen Edwin Hogben in 1903 at Ramsgate in Kent, Stephen Yarnold took the name of his stepfather, a member of the Naval Reserve, upon the death of his natural father. Educated in the local area, at the end of the First World War, Yarnold left England and moved with his family to Scotland.</p> <p>A yard boy at the Rosyth Dockyard until its closure in 1922, during this period Yarnold read widely in many fields, including the communism of Karl Marx. Frustrated in his attempts to become a Minister of the Church, Yarnold worked at several menial labouring positions until the General Strike of 1926. It was in this year at the age of twenty-three, he emigrated to Australia. Taking up home missionary work upon his arrival, in 1929 Yarnold entered the Theological Hall at Ormond College to study for the cloth.</p> <p>A student at Ormond for some four years, Yarnold then spent time in the Western district of Victoria, and worked the depression out in a Mission at Fitzroy, before being ordained as a full Minister of the Presbyterian Church and receiving his first Parish at Port Campbell. Appointed Chaplain of Scotch College the year after, in 1935, Yarnold was to draw unwanted attention from both within the Church and the Melbourne Establishment for his outspoken anti-war views and unorthodox political beliefs. This conflict coming to a head in 1945, when Yarnold was forced to resign from Scotch. Briefly becoming an Army Chaplain in Darwin, Yarnold returned to Victoria to embark upon a new career, this time writing scripts and producing 35 mm. films for the Australian Religious Film Society (ARFS).</p> <p>Married to Winifred Jacobs in 1946, in 1950 Yarnold became the Chaplain of the Union Memorial Church in North Melbourne as well as retaining the position of Chairman of the Presbyterian Theological Education Committee. During this period, Yarnold also worked as a part-time Presbyterian-Methodist Chaplain at Pentridge Goal, spending time with those prisoners in the Remand Section. In 1963 at the age of fifty-nine, Yarnold was inducted for a twelve-month term as Moderator-Designate of the Victorian Presbyterian Church. Later in 1970, after some 20 years as a Minister of the Presbyterian Church, Yarnold resigned his chaplaincy of the Union Memorial Church and moved with his wife, Winnie, to Sylvan.</p> <p>An outspoken protester against the war in Vietnam, Stephen Edwin Yarnold died in September of 1978.</p>
