HISTORICAL NOTE	Jan Chapman-Davis was born on 13 February 1947 in Geelong, Victoria. She was Catholic school educated and began work in a shoe factory aged fourteen. After marriage at eighteen and having four children, Chapman-Davis knew she was a lesbian and left in 1973 to live in the first of many lesbian households. Active in 1970s women's marches and protests, she ran a handyperson's workshop during International Women's Year 1975 for International Women's Day week at Monash University. While employed at the Women's Liberation Halfway House in 1980, Chapman-Davis participated in making the film, Women Break Out, as a boom operator. In 1988 she took part in Sydney's Long March, the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Bicentennial protest as a way of coming to terms with her Aboriginality. Eligible for Abstudy, she returned to study, immersed herself in activities and became part of the Victorian Aboriginal community. In much the same way as her Aboriginal grandmother before her, Chapman-Davis has become an all-important influence on her nine grandchildren.
