HISTORICAL NOTE	The Women's Building Council (1979-1992) comprised representatives from all the activist collectives that held meetings and/or rented space in the Women's Liberation Building at its various locations in West Melbourne and Fitzroy. The Council met monthly to make decisions about anything affecting the WL Building, such as the signing of the yearly lease, the paying of utility bills, the collecting of rent from each collective and general maintenance issues. The Council was often fully preoccupied with fund-raising the substantial amount of money it took to maintain the building in order to keep it open and accessible. The main fundraising activity the Council undertook in later years was organising both the Summer and Winter Women's Balls at the San Remo Ballroom and the St Kilda and Melbourne Town Halls. The group of activist collectives renting space at the Women's Cultural Palace and meeting monthly in 1979 was called the Queen's Council.
