Feminist activists were asked to document their experiences in the WLM by filling out a questionnaire that covered details about their personal backgrounds, the activist collectives to which they belonged, the events in which they participated, the paid and unpaid work they did as feminists and any other anecdotal comments they cared to make about their time as feminists. The WMR collective met regularly for a couple of years or so, some interested feminists did fill out and send in their questionnaires but the collective folded through lack of ongoing interest in the project.
