Run by a feminist, non-hierarchical collective of women, the Centre provided a venue for women's groups to meet, disseminated information about Women's Studies and counter-sexist education and supported the development of courses and links between all levels of education, both formal and informal. The Centre's aims included becoming a publishing group for women and a resource for Women's Studies, increasing the focus on women writers and their published material and furthering the establishment of a network of women writers. The WSC was funded by money sourced from the Commonwealth Employment Program (CEP) and ran for approximately twelve months before it folded due to lack of on-going financial support.
