<b>HISTORICAL NOTE</b>	<p>Glenda Ballantyne was born on 4 July 1955. She attended Templestowe High School before undertaking a Bachelor of Arts in History and Politics at the University of Melbourne. In 2001, she completed a PhD in Sociology at La Trobe University. She was active in the Women's Liberation Club at Melbourne University, 1974–1977, and in the Melbourne Women's Liberation Movement operating out of the Women's Centre in the 1970s, where she was involved in a number of specific campaigns as well as being a member of the Publications Committee. Ballantyne was a contributing editor of the socialist-feminist magazine, <i>Scarlet Woman</i>, 1978–1979, and was a founding director of Sybylla Co-operative Press and Publications, where she worked in various capacities from 1976–1989. She was instrumental in expanding the printing side of Sybylla into an innovative and award-winning women's publishing house.</p>
