HISTORICAL NOTE	After the success of the Lesbian Festival and Conference 1990 organisers were keen to have an annual LesFest in Melbourne. The Lesbian Festival 1991 (23–28 January) was launched with a rally in Melbourne's City Square and a Gala Opening at the Myer Music Bowl. Workshops, plays, live music, a dog show and market were held at the Footscray Community Arts Centre as well as the Summer Ball at St Kilda Town Hall and a pool party at Collingwood Leisure Centre. Lesbian Festival 1992 (8 October – 3 November) events included an International Lesbian Day march and rally, plays, a Trade Fair and Market Day at La Trobe University, a Brunswick Baths Swim Night and a Matrix Guild Forum. Despite organisers focusing on coordinating events and publicity rather than trying to finance the entire festival in order to avoid the previous year's loss, this was the last of the annual Melbourne LesFests. These collections are No.96 and No.104 of the Victorian Women's Liberation and Lesbian Feminist Archive.
