HISTORICAL NOTE	Jan Testro (aka Jan Gladys) was born on 23 August 1953 in Melbourne. She disliked school and failed year 12 twice. As a teenager, she was involved in projects for children, including a Richmond shop front kids' library. After leaving school she worked as an 'apprentice' at Walker Press, in a factory and as a motor-bike courier. While living in Western Australia in the mid-1970s, she undertook library work in Community Education Centres and immersed herself in lesbian culture, politics and activism, including participating in a reprint of Valerie Solanus' SCUM – Society for Cutting up Men Manifesto and distributing Around the Cauldron publications. Testro lived in the Valley (part of the Women's Lands in New South Wales) where she began using the name Jan Gladys. She returned to Melbourne and helped organize the Amazon Games and Lesbian Art Works exhibitions from 1996 to 1998. She also produced the Matrix Guild Inc's Lesbian Health, Independence and Wellbeing Resource for older lesbians. Jan also went the the Pine Cap Women's Peace Camp in 1993 and during the 1990s was a founding member of the collective that organised the Annual Lesbian Art Exhibition at the Brunswick Mechanics Institute and was a founding member of the Performing Older Women's Circus where she played with the Music Group in the the first POW show, Act Your Age,in 1995.  Jan bought a house and moved to Barwon Head in the late 1990s to live and study and continue her political involvement in several important campaigns in the local area. After a brief illness, Jan Gladys Testro died peacefully early on the morning of 8 March 2010, International Women's Day, in the Elouera Nursing Home in Torquay. Jan's funeral was held at Barwon Heads on 12 March and her ashes were scattered at the Williamstown Pier on 2 May.
