HISTORICAL NOTE	The Lesbian Line (LL) collective was formed in 1981 to provide a telephone information, support and referral service for lesbians by lesbians. Collective members were expected to make a commitment for twelve to eighteen months. Situated in successive Women's Liberation Buildings and sharing the telephone with Women's Liberation Switchboard, Lesbian Line began operating every Thursday 12.30–2.30pm and 6–10pm in July 1981. The collective met regularly to organise publicity for newsletters and the 3CR women's programs, to update the resource file and for rostering purposes. Many hundreds of calls were handled every year, including queries from women questioning their sexuality and needing to talk through issues with a friendly and sympathetic listener. All calls were logged and finances were raised by donations and fundraisers. However, with the establishment of the Gay and Lesbian Switchboard in 1991, there was less demand for Lesbian Line's services and it folded in October 1995.
