#### <u>Historical Note:</u>

"The most influential Suburban Watchdog in Melbourne. It has the biting power of a yard full of Doberman Pincers." This is how the Herald daily described the Carlton Association 24 December 1971. Late in 1968 two separate groups of residents, one in North Carlton and another in Central Carlton were getting organized. At a combined meeting March 17 1969 they resolved that a Carlton Association be formed.

"There was a growing concern that the activities of the State and Municipal Governments along with those of private developers were destroying the physical and social fabric of the area." (2) The mid sixties had already seen residents achieve success when the Carlton Business and Property Owners Association had stymied a major redevelopment project. The Carlton Association also took heart from the success of the Paddington Society in Sydney.

From the outset, the Association benifited from a well organized, eloquent and educated leadership. Its organization entailed an elected twelve person executive committee and

twenty or more Sub - Committees or Action Groups formed as the need arose. The functioning of this system was lateral and fluid. The Action groups had a great deal of autonomy and reported to the Committee who was responsible for over all policy.

At one point there were 1500 volunteers on the files. The Association was broadly based and had the support and confidence of the Community. It also "marshalled support from the Unions, The National Trust, Government Departments, the Council and Professional Institutes." (3) The Association effectively used well documented reports, correspondence and dialogue with public authorities, public meetings, door to door contact and the press. It didn't just protest, it fought campaigns. The Carlton Association is an ongoing Organization.
