Trades Union from 1890-1960. During this time the union underwent a number of name changes and its actual formation pre-dates 1890.

A Tailors' Society was first formed in Melbourne on the 22nd September 1866. This organization eventually collapsed in 1869 due to financial difficulties. It was refounded in June 1870 as the Tailors' Trade Protection Society and began meeting with the Tailoresses' Society (formed by 1883) in 1905. A Pressers' Union had begun by 1884 and in 1902 amalgamated with the Cutters' and Joiners' Union to form the Victorian Clothing Operatives' Union. In 1907 all these groups combined to form the Victorian branch of the Federated Clothing Trades Union of the Commonwealth of Australia. This union won Conciliation and Arbitration Court registration on the 6th June 1907. As other elements of the trade were incorporated into the union the federation changed names, firstly to the Federated Clothing and Allied Trades Union (13/1/1922), then to the Amalgamated Clothing and Allied Trades Union (4/8/1924), and finally becoming the Clothing and Allied Trades Union of Australia (22/1/1947). Within this collection there is some material relating to the earlier unions such as the minutes of the Tailors' Society (1890-1907) and assorted accounts and rule books of the Pressers' Union, the Tailoresses' Union and the Victorian Clothing Operatives Union. However, the Australian National University Archives in Canberra holds the bulk of surviving material concerning clothing trade unions prior to 1890, together with later records of the federal body and state branches (other than Victoria). See attached A.N.U. Archives listing. All Victorian branch material post 1960 is still held at the union office, Melbourne Trades Hall.
