HISTORICAL NOTE	<p>Ellinor Gertrude Harris (known as Gertrude) was born in 1895. She was the eldest of the five children of Alice and Albert Harris. Albert Harris was a music teacher and all the children were encouraged to take up music from an early age although all, except Gertrude were, visually impaired. Her sister, Adela, was born in 1899 and also became a music teacher. Alice Harris died in 1907 leaving the children to be raised by their domineering father who deemed that Gertrude was the only daughter to receive a complete education. She attended Baldur Girls Grammar School and took music examinations at the Royal Academy of Music & Royal College of Music and became a music teacher; both she and Adela also composed music. As well as teaching music, throughout her life, Gertrude worked with charities such as the Institute for the blind. When she died, on 16 August 1987, she bequeathed the proceeds of her estate "to the University of Melbourne Conservatorium for use in the furtherance of its general purposes" now known as the Ellinor Gertrude Harris Bequest administered by the Faculty of Music.</p>
