THE MELBOURNE SCOTS

HISTORICAL NOTE

On the 8 October, 1919 a group of men met for lunch at Scott's Hotel, Melbourne. They were James Dyer, James Campbell, David Carnegie, W.H. MacLennan, Dr. T. Taylor Downie, Dr. J.F. Agnew, R. Ferguson, Allan Morrison and Alex A. Laing. They decided to form a society in Melbourne composed of men of Scottish descent.

This group of men met again on the 16 October, 1919 and made James Dyer chairman of their society. The name 'The Melbourne Scots' was formally adopted and the membership was limited to one hundred.

The first 'Annual General Meeting' was held on the 11 March, 1920 where the Society elected James Dyer as its first president, W.H. MacLennan, Dr. J.F. Agnew and Dr. T. Taylor Downie as vice-presidents. James Campbell was elected Honorary Treasurer and Bruce Laing, Honorary Secretary. The Committee was comprised of Allan Morrisen, A. McGeachy, A.A. Laing, Lt. Col. D.S. Wanlis, and Hon. J.A. Boyd. The name 'committee' was later changed to 'council'.

St. Andrew's Day Dinners

Since 1923 The Melbourne Scots have held St. Andrew's Day Dinners. In the early years these dinners were held at Scott's Hotel. Council members and distinguished guests and speakers would be assembled by the secretary in the Oak Room on the first floor of Scott's Hotel, and then piped down to dinner where the main body of members and guests were seated.

It was a tradition at these dinners that the haggis was always to be carried in by the Chef. The dress code at St. Andrew's Day dinners was always formal.

These St. Andrew's Day celebrations were always held at night except during the Second World War. In 1942-43 and 1943-44, St. Andrew's Day was celebrated at a Luncheon. After the War the celebrations returned to evening dinners.

Burns Night

The Melbourne Scots held their first Burns Night in 1935 on the 175th Anniversary of the birth of Robert Burns. Apart from a lapse in 1939 and 1940 these dinners were held annually. At these dinners members of the Society and/or distinguished guests were asked to give the Burns Night Orations or Addresses.

Prominent Members of The Melbourne Scots

- . Founder of the Melbourne Scots was Alex Laing.
- . C.N. McKenzie, President 1934-1948/9.
- . R.G. Menzies, President, 1949- ? .
- . Captain W. Kirkhope, Secretary, ? - 1937. Served in WWII.
- . C. Waugh, Secretary, 1937-1958, then Vice-president 1958.
- . J.P. Beveridge, Snr. (d. by 1854) - always smoked a cigar. Part of McLaren Industries, Cnr. George + Webb Streets, Fitzroy.
- . J.P. Beveridge, Jnr., Historian for the Melbourne Scots. He was also a pianist.
- . C.J. Cruickshank, singer. (d. late 1950's).
- . Malcolm Moore (d. by early 1970's).
- . Charlie Wilson, owner of Scott's Hotel.
- . George E. Knox of Eagle Star Insurance. Described by R.G. Menzies as 'a thrawn man'.
