<b>HISTORICAL NOTE</b>	<p>Dr. Foenander graduated LL.B. from the University of Melb. in 1914. He was admitted by the Supreme Court of Victoria as a barrister and solicitor in 1915. After brief employment as a lawyer Foenander worked as a tutor at Ormond College. In 1920 he was appointed part-time lecturer in European History and also in Political Economy, and in 1925 he was a part-time lecturer in Economics in the new Commerce Faculty. In 1947 Foenander was appointed Senior Lecturer in Industrial Relations and six years later became Associate Professor of Commerce. He is best known as the author of numerous works on industrial relations and retired from full-time teaching in 1957 and part-time teaching in 1969.</p>

GENERAL NOTE: Dr. Foenander was educated at Wesley College and at The University of Melbourne where he graduated LL.B. in 1914. He was articled for a year, and in 1915 was admitted by the Supreme Court of Victoria to practise as a barrister and solicitor. A short period in partnership with a Melbourne solicitor followed, but he was "not happy in this life" and after being rejected for war service, accepted an appointment as tutor in History, Political Economy and Laws at Ormond College, continuing at first to do private legal work.

In 1920 he was appointed to a part-time lectureship in European History and another in Political Economy in the Faculty of Arts, and in 1925 added to his various part-time appointments another part-time lectureship in Economics in the new Faculty of Commerce. In 1947 he was appointed Senior Lecturer in Industrial Relations in the Faculty of Economics and Commerce, in 1950-51 and again in 1953-54 acted as Professor of Commerce, and in 1953 was appointed Associate Professor of Commerce. In 1954 he became Head of the new Department of Industrial Relations. He retired from full-time teaching in 1957, and from part-time teaching in 1969. In 1949 he received the honorary degree of D.Litt., and in 1975 that of M.Com. He died on 22 February 1985.
