HISTORICAL	Mina Fink nee Miriam Waks, was born in 1913 in Bialystok, Poland Orphaned as a young child and raised by grandparents, she matriculated in 1932. In the same year she married Leo Fink and emigrated to Australia. From 1944 to 1947, Mina Fink was president of the Ladies Group of the United Jewish Overseas Relief Fund which involved collecting and packing parcels of clothing and food to send to refugees and war victims overseas. In 1947 she was an executive member of the Australian Jewish Welfare and Relief Society and in this capacity she me new immigrants, helped to establish migrant hostels run by the AJWRS conducted fund raising activities and assisting orphans. Mina Fink was the Director of the Australian Jewish Welfare and Relief Society (1947- 1976), President of the National Council of Jewish Women Victorian Section (1958-1960) and its National President (1967-1973), foundation worker for the Jewish Holocaust Museum; chairman and delegate to several other Jewish Councils. Mina Fink was awarded an MBE for community service, particularly to Jewish women. She died in 1991. Fo Leo Fink's historical note see his curriculum vitae

Introduction to the Fink Collection

Leo Fink was born to Jewish parents, Mordechai Meir and Masha Fink, in Białystock, Russia in 1901. After a sound education in both Hebrew and the Talmud, Leo spent two years working on a Kibbutz in Israel and later studied civil engineering at university in Germany.

Between 1926 and 1928, Leo's family operated a woollen mill in Romania which was sold prior to the Fink brothers emigrating to Australia in 1928. Leo, Wolf and Sydney Fink settled initially in Berwick, Victoria via a scheme established specifically for Jewish migrants. One year later they were joined by another brother, Jack Fink, who brought with him a knitting machine which enabled them to eventually establish several businesses; United Woollen Mills, United Carpet Mills and Unilon in Thomastown.

During a return visit to Bialystock in 1932, Leo married Miriam Waks (Mina Fink), a woman of Polish Jewish descent who was orphaned at a young age and raised by her grandparents.

Mr and Mrs Lco and Mina Fink were prominent members of the Victorian Jewish community, involving themselves in numerous organisations including Kadimah, United Jewish Overseas Relief Fund and the Victorian Jewish Board of Deputies.

Leo was well known for his support of programmes for postwar Jewish migration to Australia and he personally lobbied the Minister for Immigration Arthur Calwell. Similarly, Leo encouraged the traditional education of Jewish children in Melbourne.

Mina Fink's curriculum vitae demonstrates her tireless work for Jewish organisations including a term as President of the National Council of Jewish Women and fundraising for a Holocaust Museum. She and Leo had two children, Freda born in 1933 and Nathan born in 1935.



The Fink Collection contains an ensemble of personal papers, various correspondence for Jewish organisations (minutes, agendas, speeches, reports etc), administrative material for postwar immigration and business papers all pertaining to Leo and/or Mina Fink.
