<b>HISTORICAL NOTE</b>	<p>The Women's Liberation Switchboard (WLS) was founded in 1979 by women formerly responsible for the defunct Women's Liberation Centre telephone service. It provided information and a referral service for women seeking refuges and other support services. Volunteers to the Switchboard worked four- hourly shifts for twelve hours a day, seven days a week. In 1980 WLS received government funding on the condition that it added Women's Refuge Referral Service (WRRS) to its title. The WLS and WRRS then effectively ran two distinct services: the WRS had paid workers and the WLS was run by volunteers who gave information of women's liberation-related activities. In 1984 the two groups became officially autonomous. WLS closed in 1992.</p> <p>This collection is No.17 of the Victorian Women's Liberation and Lesbian Feminist Archives</p>
