<b>HISTORICAL NOTE</b>	The Hon. Sir George Oswald Reid was born 1903 and educated at the University of Melbourne where he graduated L.L.B. After practicing as a solicitor and barrister, Reid was the Liberal member for Box Hill in the Victorian Legislative Assembly, from 1947 to 1952 and from 1955 until his retirement in 1973. During his career, Reid held a number of portfolios in the Government, including Labour and Industry and Electrical Undertakings 1956-1965, Fuel and Power 1965-1967, Immigration 1967-1970 and Attorney-General 1967-1973. Morris Thomas Williams succeeded Reid as the Liberal Member for Box Hill in 1973.
