These records are concerned with the <u>Sugar Works Employees'</u>
<u>Union of Australia</u>, established around 1900 as the <u>Victorian</u>
<u>Sugar Refinery Employees' Union</u>. In 1911 the Union was registered with the Conciliation and Arbitration Court in the name under which it is listed. The collection is mainly concerned with the Yarraville Refinery in Victoria, but it also includes lively correspondence with the <u>Pyrmont Sugar Works</u>
<u>Employees' Union</u> in Sydney, and with the <u>Sugar Refining</u>
<u>Employees' Union</u> in Frementle, WA. The Union amalgamated with the AWU in 1975.

These records cover familiar industrial matters, and also particularly reflect the social aspects of work and unionism. As the membership shows, most Union members were from the western suburbs of Melbourne; and this was a small, cohesive and strongly social Union.
