<u>GENERAL NOTE</u> : George Richard Tibbits was born in Boulder, W.A., 7th November, 1933 and educated at State schools in W.A. and Colac, Victoria, and at The University of Melbourne (B.Arch. Dip. TRP). As a composer, he is largely selftaught, acquiring a theoretical grounding through the study of composers such as Schönberg and Cage. "Indeed", he wrote in 1976, "as an outsider in music, I have been greatly stimulated by the critical disinterest and hostility which my participation has created". Tibbits was a foundation member of the Carlton Association in its siege against the Victorian Housing Commission's notions of "slum" clearance and urban renewal.
