By 1930 the firm was known as A C Leith and had taken over Haddon & Henderson, a practice that had existed since the late 1800s. The present firm was formed in 1936 when A C Leith joined in partnership with Harold E Bartlett, and the firm name changed to A C Leith & Bartlett, Architects and Engineers. It was incorporated under the Companies Act in 1957 as Leith & Bartlett Pty Ltd, directed by Architects, Engineers and Town Planners.

Practice revived by A.C. Leith, as A.C. Leith & Associates, Architects and Engineers.

Approx. 1930

A.C. Leith & Associates took over the practice operated since pre-century days by Robert J. Haddon and William A. Henderson, who practised as Haddon & Henderson, Architects.

1936

A.C. Leith joined in partnership by Harold E. Bartlett, and the firm name changed to A.C. Leith & Bartlett, Architects and Engineers.

1945

Practice moved from 408 Collins Street to 628 Bourke Street, Melbourne.

1950

Practice moved from 628 Bourke Street, Melbourne to present premises 458 St. Kilda Road, Melbourne.

1957

Practice incorporated under the Companies Act into the present practice of Leith & Bartlett Pty. Ltd., directed by Architects, Engineers and Town Planners; Directors of which now are:-
