A member of many feminist activist groups, including the Melbourne Scarlet Woman editorial group, Otto worked as an Outreach Youth Worker (1976–1986) and was instrumental in establishing What Are Ya?, a support group for young women. After working as State-wide Coordinator of the Youth Accommodation Coalition of Victoria (1984-1989), Otto became a law student and research assistant in The University of Melbourne's Law Faculty (1990-1992). In 1993 Otto was the Regional Coordinator for Amnesty International and lectured in the Law Faculty, University of Melbourne, from 1994. Otto was appointed an Associate Professor in 2002. She has written extensively on human rights law, economic, social and cultural rights, and feminist legal theory.
