HISTORICAL	Educated at University College, Priestley was appointed geologist to Shackleton's antarctic expedition of 1907 to 1909 and to Scott's expedition from 1910 to 1913. After war service where he received the Military Cross, Raymond Priestley resumed an academic and administrative career at Cambridge. In 1934, he reluctantly became the first salaried Vice Chancellor of Melborune University. Priestley's main concern was to re-establish adequate funding and community support for the University. He was frustrated in these attempts, and he became the Vice-Chancellor of the University of Birmingham and left Melbourne in 1938. Priestley acted as an adviser to the BBC and, after his retirement in 1952, he served as Chairman of the Royal Commission on Civil Service and on a series of boards and associations.
