<b>HISTORICAL NOTE</b>	<p>Major Colin Campbell acted as Honorary Secretary to the University Council from May 1853 until October that year when Edward Graves Mayne was appointed the University's first Registrar. The Registrar's responsibilities included oversight of for accounts, correspondence, student admissions and enrolments, staff appointments staff records and administration of the faculties through assistant registrars (later faculty general managers). The position came under the direction of the council and its committees. In 1999 the registrar's functions were divided between the newly-formed University Secretary and the Vice-Principal (Administration). Nineteenth Century Registrars were Edward Graves Mayne (1853-1855), John Frederick James 1856-1864), John Madden (1864) and Edward Fitzhayley A'Beckett (1864-1902).</p>
