<b>HISTORICAL NOTE</b>	<p>Ralph McLean was a history student at the University of Melbourne where he became involved in student politics. He was Secretary of the Student Representative Council and research officer for the Australian Union of Students. He was an active member of the Fitzroy community and a member of the local ALP Branch; in 1982 he was elected a Councillor of the City of Fitzroy, and became Mayor of Fitzroy in 1984. McLean was also involved with Victoria's arts community particularly La Mama, the Melbourne Fringe Festival, Triple R radio and community television Channel 31. He worked as a healthcare consultant and was a strong advocate for improvement to rural health services; he was executive director of the Australian Federation of AIDS Organisations. Ralph McLean died 25 December 2010.</p>
