HISTORICAL NOTE	<p>Hilary McPhee and Diana Gribble established their publishing firm, the McPhee Gribble Company in 1975. Hilary had a background in editing, and Diana in printing, design and production. They specialised at first in writing and packaging children's books, and in joint initiatives with other publishers like Penguin and the University of Queensland Press. Together with Penguin they produced the successful Practical Puffin Description. At the same time they built up a successful adult publishing list of fiction and non-fiction. Hilary ran the publishing side of the business, working with authors and in charge of overseas liaisons. Diana Gribble was in charge of production from manuscript to distribution.</p> <p>The Company incorporated in 1979 with Hilary McPhee and Diana Gribble as directors and sole shareholders, becoming McPhee Gribble Pty Ltd. In 1976 the Company moved from its first address in Jolimont to William St, South Yarra and in 1980 to premises at 203 Drummond St, Carlton.</p> <p>In 1983 McPhee Gribble entered an arrangement with Penguin Australia, in which Penguin handled the marketing and distribution of McPhee Gribble books, which were published under a joint imprint. McPhee Gribble retained editorial independence.</p> <p>The company moved premises again in 1983 to 66 Cecil St, Fitzroy.</p> <p>By 1988 McPhee Gribble had published 250 titles and launched some notable Australian writers, like Helen Garner. In addition Australian books they published Australian editions of overseas titles. In September 1989 McPhee Gribble broke away from the relationship to Penguin to handle its own marketing and to publish under its own imprint. Penguin retained the distribution of McPhee Gribble books.</p> <p>On November 30 1990 McPhee Gribble sold to Penguin Australia its publishing assets, name and goodwill.</p>
DATE OF TRANSFER	The collection was acquired by the University of Melbourne in late 1990.
ACCESS CONDITIONS	Open. [Previous period of restriction ended on January 1 st , 2010].

DESCRIPTION	This collection contains the entire body of records from McPhee Gribble at the time the company was sold to Penguin Australia in November 1990.
NOTE ON COLLECTIONS	Collection originally contained many thermal faxes. Owing to their poor quality and rapidly fading legibility these were photocopied on to stable acid-free paper at the time this collection was acquired and re-boxed in 1990.
