<b>HISTORICAL NOTE</b>	<p>Murielle Crawford was born in c.1885 and died in 1969. Employed at Rothwells Ltd as a shirt-maker in West End, South Brisbane, Miss Crawford corresponded with her sweetheart, Frederick Kitching of the 49th Battalion "somewhere in France". They had met in 1909 when he emigrated from Burneston, Yorkshire to Queensland for health reasons. Kitching worked as a labourer in Murgon, a town in the Burnett district given to dairy farming and timber cutting. Until Kitching's death in February 1918 from an inflamed kidney, Murielle and Fred corresponded vigorously. Murielle also corresponded with Kitching's family in Burneston, Yorkshire. After Fred's death, Murielle retained a solid interest in military affairs.</p>

Series include correspondence from Murielle and Fred; between Fred and his family; between Murielle and Fred's family; postcards to Murielle and others; war souvenirs; Murielle's personal papers; photographs.</p>

### MURIELLE CRAWFORD COLLECTION

Murielle Crawford was born in c.1885, and died in 1969. For the most part this collection embraces the period 1906-1920. Employed at Rothwells Ltd. as a shirt-maker in West End, South Brisbane, Miss Crawford corresponded with her sweetheart Frederick Kitching of the 49th Battalion "somewhere in France". The latter met Ms.Crawford in 1909 when he emigrated from Burneston, Yorkshire to Queensland for health reasons. Kitching worked as a labourer in Murgon, a town in the Burnett district given to dairy-farming and timber cutting.

Until Kitching's death in February 1918 from an inflamed kidney, Murielle Crawford and the latter corresponded vigourously. In addition, Murielle corresponded with the Kitching family in Burneston, Yorkshire. This network of correspondence and postcards have generated material of acute historical and sociological interest.

Murielle and Fred's correspondence and postcards deal with a variety of issues: courtship c.1910-1920, and the commonplace allied viewpoint of Germany. Further, this sub-group furnishes a useful account of daily life at the Front. The correspondence and postcards Murielle received from Ethel and Etta Kitching are often of the gushy and unconvincing order, but pressing concerns often foregrounded are the restrictions on food and goods, the entry of women into jobs traditionally held by men, and German Zeppelins dropping bombs and pamphlets over England. The orientation of War Memorabilia in the collection suggests that after Fred's death, Murielle retained a solid interest in military affairs.
