HISTORICAL	The main Trade Union Unemployment Centre was established in 1983, while the Western Region Office was opened in 1985, and was run by Alan Aithorpe. Both offices became defunct in 1986. It was funded through the affiliation fees of thirty-eight left-wing unions, with additional funds from the Department of Labour and Industry. It provided support and information to the unemployed, and researched and lobbied for the creation of new jobs. It had links with shop stewards' committees, the ALP, and other left-wing and Western Region organisations. The main centre operated at the Victorian Trades Hall Council under Peter Green.

#### **HISTORICAL NOTE:**

The Trade Union Unemployment Centre was set up in July 1983 by the Trade Union Committee Against Poverty and Unemployment. It was funded by union affiliation fees (35 unions were affiliated at 1985) and a State Government grant. The Centre had an office in Victorian Trades Hall until its closure in 1988 [?], and also a branch office at Slater & Gordon Solicitors in Footscray. The Centre acted as a advocacy and policy group for unemployed workers, and had strong links with the Metal Workers Union and the Western suburbs.

The TUUC was involved in campaigns, lobbying and policy development on various issues. These included industry development, job creation and socially useful work, abolition of youth wages, welfare and social security issues, development of a log of claims for the unemployed. The collection of the TUUC Library was placed with the VTHC after the closure of the TUUC in c.1987/1988.

It sat in the VTHC Library as a separate collection until the VTHC Library move forced a cull of it in 1994. The collection was barely used in this period and was a collection of working subject boxes and files, rather than a planned developed collection. As such, much of the material was well out of date and no longer relevant.

Working from the TUUC produced index to the collection, the VTHC Librarian culled and disposed the bulk of the material available elsewhere. Material relating to unemployment was offered to the University of Melbourne Archives and is contained in this collection. Notes on what the collection originally contained and what was disposed are contained in the first file in this collection.
