<b>HISTORICAL NOTE</b>	Sir David Derham graduated in Arts in 1941, served in the 2nd A.I.F. (rising to Major), and returned to take a Law Degree. He practiced as a barrister, and tutored in Law at Queen's College from 1948 to 1951, became Independent Lecturer in Constitutional Law at the University in 1949, and Professor of Jurisprudence in 1951. He was Dean of the Law Faculty at Monash University from 1964 to 1968, when he returned to Melbourne as Vice-chancellor. Sir David served as Vice-chancellor from 1967 until 1982, when he retired.
